### Agenda

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- Agenda Approval – motion made to approve agenda, approved unanimously
- Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes – motioned to approve minutes, approved unanimously
- Treasurer's Report (Nathan) – Nothing to report
- At Large Rep's Report
  - Jacob Stevens
    - No Dallas County meetings – voted a chair, secretary – chair has disappeared, no official meetings being held.
  - Chris Hansen
    - Not much for updates since State Fair
- District Rep's Report
  - District 1 (Nick)
    - Not much going on, has gone to a couple of events; Johnson County meeting is next weekend
    - Working on getting his Facebook organization name changed for this year's political candidacy, and has some literature printed
  - Greg resigned
    - Chris has stepped in temporarily, but nothing to report
    - Vote to accept resignation – motion made by Nick, second by AJ. Approved unanimously.
  - District 3 (AJ)
    - Overall, it was a good event, generated lots of interest, but not optimistic about furthering this with volunteer situation – we don't have enough muscle. There have to be 2 people, and we haven't been able to keep that going
    - Paperwork needs to be in place by May – you need to have a pretty good idea who is going to be working earlier than that
    - Discussion:
      - Don't have the count for signatures yet, but focus going forward would be to have this event be focused on candidate visibility
      - Getting commitments in person at Convention would be ideal
      - Basically, State Fair costs \$300/day -

- District 4 (John)
    - Nothing to report
- Minutes from prior meetings publication - update
- Convention
  - Jules has no update about hotel yet for Convention or an event for Thomas Laehn
  - Discussion: do we want this coming Convention in Des Moines, or somewhere else?
    - In 2020, LP held Convention in Grandview, Jules will look into this as an alternate location
    - Jacob will investigate other alternative locations
- Petition collection strategy
  - We need 3500 signatures – 100 in each of 19 counties; goal is 150 for each of those counties
  - Nick is collecting for himself and Thomas Laehn; Liberty has been working on this also
  - Jules will count petitions that she has – going forward, suggests focusing on the 19 counties with the most signatures collected at the Fair
- ADDED TO AGENDA – Fundraising / Updates on Laehn campaign
  - Campaign
    - Laehn is in Boone parade on September 20; also an event around October 10?
    - Nathan – requesting registered LP voter list
  - Fundraising
    - Need a fundraising letter – Chris volunteered to work on a draft letter, Monica will help
    - Target audience, can work with prior named donors would make it a more focused effort – Jules will send the list to Ben
    - Jacob suggested also sending to Convention attendees
