- Meeting opened – 8:36pm
- Agenda Approval – Motion Nick, 2<sup>nd</sup> Chris – Approved unanimously
- Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes – Motion Nick, 2<sup>nd</sup> Chris – Approved unanimously
- Treasurer's Report (Nathan)
  - Screenshare WF account – shows balance, MailChimp deduction, donations, and reimbursements
- At Large Rep's Report
  - Jacob Stevens
    - Recruitment currently slow
  - Chris Hansen
    - Working on letters from September meeting – deferred sharing because thinks we need to include convention date
    - Working with Thomas Laehn on events in Chris' area. Coordinating another at the Green Door in Fayette on Saturday the 22<sup>nd</sup>, and tentative meeting for 21st in Buchanan, but does not have firm details. One in Clayton County for November 20 has fallen through.
- District Rep's Report
  - District 1 (Nick)
    - Busy October – lots of city council stuff, but everyone got re-elected
    - Reporters have been asking about campaign – need to set a date to finalize this campaign kickoff event
    - Has been collecting some signatures at events he is attending, including Marine event this weekend
  - District 2 (Vacant)
  - District 3 (AJ)
    - Post office update – Notified that payment was late. Filled out a form on PO Box that payment was late, and box closed. Got check returned with another note about being closed to David Green. Nathan found an email that payment needs to be in person, apparently auto-pay disrupted due to change in debit card. AJ will go to main post office tomorrow to try to straighten this out.
    - Going to start collecting signatures
  - District 4 (John)
    - Not much to report, watching local elections and trying to find out which groups he can participate in. Jacob offered to assist

- Convention
  - Can no longer hold it at Holiday Inn – not accepting reservations after November 15. However, Tai is great at event planning, has taken over this and is actively looking for space to hold it. Historical Society is one option.
  - We don't have to do caucuses to get delegates to the convention because we don't have major party status any more
- Fundraising
  - Chris will send drafted letters to Jules
- Moellman invoice – payment and auto-payment
  - CRM transition completed – he is waiving late fees this month, but invoice needs paid, and future invoices need set up on auto-pay. Nathan has a check to mail, needs to reach out about setting up auto-pay
- Signature collection
  - Jules is expecting challenges on candidates, but have had good success in Polk County
  - Jules will send petitions to everyone – we need a minimum of 19 counties with 100 signatures, and a total of 3,500, but we should be shooting for at least 4,500.
